If in doubt please phone the club on 8268 5046 to ascertain if training will take place.



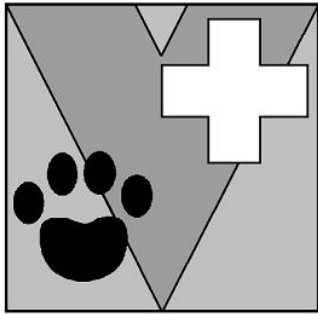
SUBMISSIONS

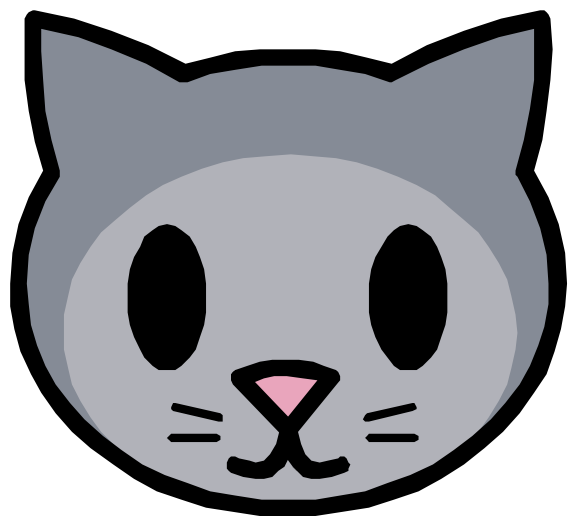
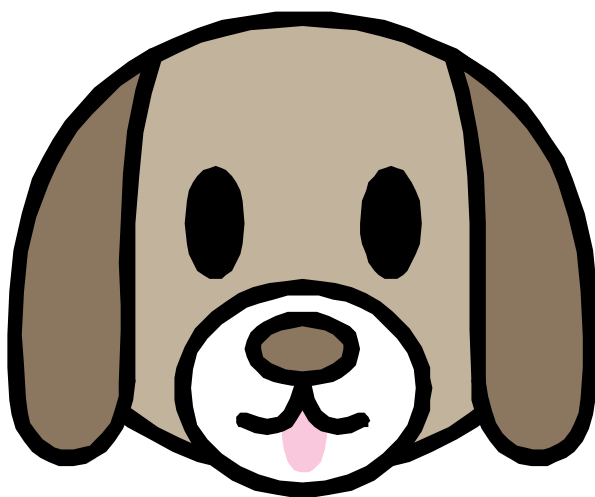
